

Instruction for Preparation of Presentations

at EPR BioDose 2022 online

Mar. 28-30, 2022

Posters

1. Check the program to get your corresponding presentation number. Please note, the presentation number is NOT the abstract number.
2. The committee will post your submitted poster file onto a virtual white board of the table allocated to you, which you will be able to access during the event.
3. Please prepare your 1-page poster using appropriate software, such as Power Point. The landscape mode is recommended as it fits a computer screen. Note, because it is an online viewing venue, the dimensions of the poster do not matter.
4. Please put your presentation number at the upper left corner of your poster.
5. If you want to participate in the prize competition (see the descriptions below), put a logo of the attached files at the upper right corner of your poster.
6. For submitting your poster file, please convert it to a jpg file. (In the case of Power Point, you can choose the file type when you save it) Please check the resolution. The size of the file should be less than 10 MB. The file name should be “presentation number” + “last name of presenter” + “.jpg”, such as “5-07-D3Toyoda.jpg”.
7. Optionally, you can make a short video of less than 3 minutes to introduce your poster. This is highly recommended as sometimes it is not easy to understand a poster just by viewing. The file should be in the mp4 format. The file name should be “presentation number” + “last name of presenter” + “.mp4”, such as “5-07-D3Toyoda.mp4”. The size should be less than 100 MB.
8. Optionally you can have links to anything related to your presentation, such as your papers or list of publications. If it is a video, it can be replaced by the poster, but you have to put the video file in some other place with your own responsibility, such as Youtube. No video file can be posted on the white board for the event. The list of URL should be saved as a text file with a name “presentation number” + “last name of presenter” + “.txt”, such as “5-07-D3Toyoda.txt”

Invited talks

Invited speakers will need to prepare a talk as usual for oral presentations. You make the presentation by sharing the screen of your computer during the event. The presentation should be less than 22 minutes with an additional 3-minutes allotted for discussion.

Poster prize competition

The poster competition will be open to Early Career Scientists which include students, PhD candidates, or scientists who received their highest certificate (e.g., BSc, MSc or PhD) within the past five years. There will be 3 non-monetary awards: two from IABERD (1 Biodosimetry, 1 EPR) and one from RENEb.

Each participant will have three votes to this competition using Google forms. You cannot vote for posters in which you are listed as a coauthor. Additionally, you cannot make multiple votes, which will be invalidated. The prize will be given at the end of General Assembly on the last day.
